



Clarice Helen (Debban) Schievelbein, age 90, of Arapahoe, Nebraska passed away on March 5, 2017 at C.A. Mues Good Samaritan Center in Arapahoe, Nebraska. She was born on February 2, 1927 in Frontier County, Nebraska to Raymond and Louise Esther (Niederberger) Debban.

Clarice was baptized at Salem Lutheran Church in Frontier County by the Rev. C.F. Schrein, and confirmed at Salem on April 6, 1939 by the Rev. Albert Cholcher. She spent her grade school years at Ash Grove & Pleasant Hill Schools. She then attended Salem Parochial School during the 8th grade. Clarice attended high school in Elwood, graduating with a Regent's Scholarship on May 17, 1945.

She taught school for about 2 years at Rural District #40 west of Bertrand, Nebraska, and then attended the University of Nebraska at Lincoln for about 1 ½ years. Along with her full time position at school, she spent many years sewing for others, teaching 4-H girls to sew and knit as well as having an upholstery business from 1967 to 1997. Clarice was a member of Arapahoe's Immanuel Lutheran Church from 1947 to 1963 and a member of Trinity Lutheran Church of Arapahoe from 1963 to present. She was active in the LWML, a member of the Trinity choir for period of time, and enjoyed her years of service to the church and her dedication to her faith. In later years, she joined in the fellowship of friends at the Arapahoe Senior Center, being a member of the local card club and a weekly Bible Study group. During her retirement years, Clarice resided at Arapahoe's Sunshine Village, Good Samaritan's Assisted Living, Mother Hull Home in Kearney, and the Good Samaritan Center in Arapahoe.
